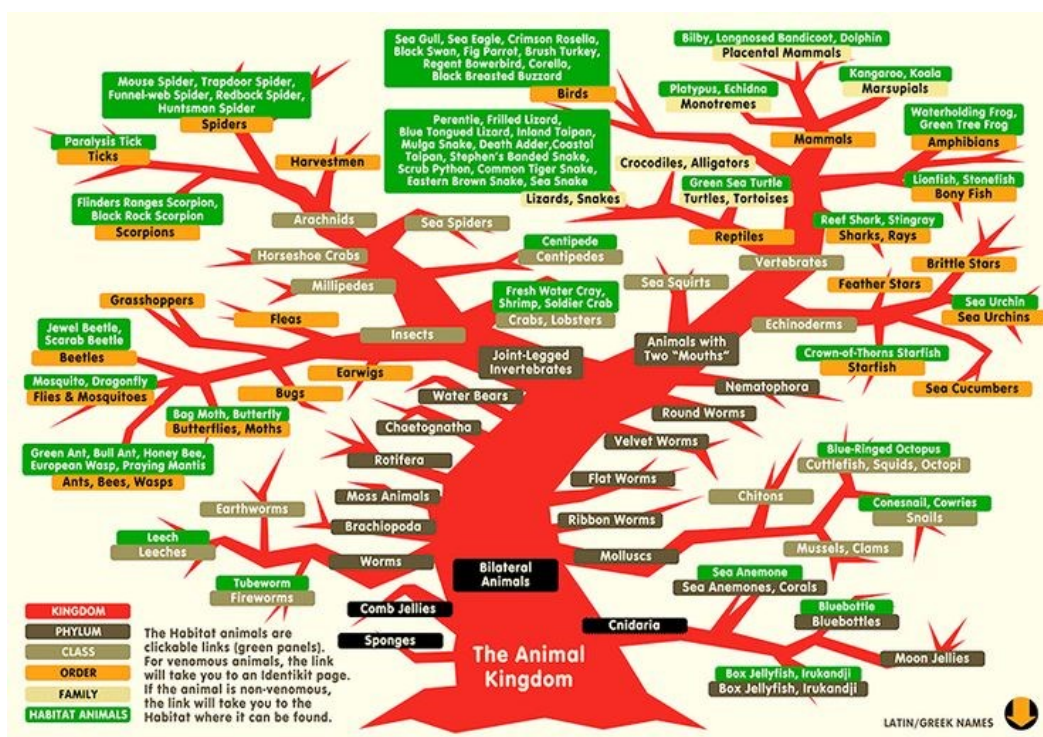
On occasions, some elements of this curriculum plan may be adapted to meet the needs and interests of the children.
